

Race KC Series Scoring System & Rules

1. Competition is open to all KCTC members.
2. Anyone at any point in the season placing in the top five in their age group is recorded and a part of the competition but you can only win if you are a member. Standings are updated and published on the Kansas City Track Club website (www.kctrack.org) and Facebook page as the season progresses.
3. Active KCTC membership must be in place by Nov. 1st of the series year to receive final recognition and awards, unless otherwise noted.
4. Points are based on performance in 5-year age groups from 20-24 thru 80+.
5. Scoring is five deep in each age group in all races as follows
 - a. 10 points for 1st place
 - b. 8 points for 2nd place
 - c. 6 points for 3rd place
 - d. 4 points for 4th place
 - e. 2 points for 5th place
6. KCTC owned races, Westport St Patrick's Day Run and Cliff Hanger, are worth double points.
7. KCTC volunteer opportunities will earn participants 5 points, with a max of 3 volunteer events going towards your final score. Volunteers must be signed up appropriately and checked in with the volunteer coordinator to earn points. Only Westport St. Patrick's Day Run, Cliff Hanger, Brew to Brew, and both KCTC Water Stations at Hospital Hill and KC Marathon will qualify as volunteer events.
8. Best ten race scores will count, with 100 points the maximum score possible encouraging quality over quantity of races.
9. Competition races range from 5K to Half Marathon.
10. Road races are on USATF certified courses, except trail races.
11. Chip time will be used to determine place finish and award points.
12. In any race with more than one distance there will be only one designated race.
13. When moving from one age group to another during the year, points will be scored in both age groups, added together and counted in the age group where the most points have been scored.
14. Points must be scored in at least 3 Race KC Series races to be eligible for prizes
15. Prizes will be awarded to the top five finishers in each age group at the Awards Celebration.
16. There will be approximately 20 races in the series
17. Each race will provide 7 comp entries for the next year's race to be distributed to winners.
18. Each race includes KCTC flyers in the race packets. References to KCTC and the Race KC Series on printed and social media would be greatly appreciated.
